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Exam Structure (New Scheme)

CA Intermediate has two groups of three papers each. You may appear group-wise or attempt both together — and the aggregate rule often makes attempting both the smarter choice.

Group I

- Paper 1: Advanced Accounting
- Paper 2: Corporate & Other Laws
- Paper 3: Taxation (Income Tax + GST)

Group II

- Paper 4: Cost & Management Accounting
- Paper 5: Auditing & Ethics
- Paper 6: Financial Management & Strategic Management

Pass: 40% in each paper and 50% aggregate per group. Score 60+ in a paper for a permanent exemption.

Six-Step First-Attempt Strategy

- Attempt both groups if time permits — a strong Accounts or FM score lifts weaker papers via aggregate.
- Treat ICAI Study Material, RTPs, MTPs and past papers as the syllabus (60-70% mapping).
- Practise Tax and Costing numericals daily — these create first-attempt passes.
- Write like ICAI wants: working notes, section numbers in Law, headings in theory.
- Three full mocks per group in the last six weeks with honest self-evaluation.
- Revise every chapter three times; keep a one-page summary each.

Mistakes That Cost Attempts

- Ignoring ICAI material in favour of coaching notes alone.
- Postponing theory papers to the last month.
- No answer-writing practice under time pressure.
- Leaving GST amendments for the very end.
