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What is CUET-UG?

The Common University Entrance Test (CUET-UG), conducted by NTA, is the gateway to undergraduate admissions in central and many other universities across India. It is a computer-based test.

- Section IA/IB: Languages (13 + 20 languages).
- Section II: Domain subjects (choose as per your course).
- Section III: General Test (for courses that need it).
- Based largely on the Class 12 NCERT syllabus.

How to Choose Subjects

- Pick domain subjects that match your desired course and your Class 12 stream.
- Check each university's required subject combination before choosing.
- One language is compulsory; choose the one you are strongest in.
- Attempt the General Test if your target course asks for it.

Preparation Strategy

- Master NCERT for every domain subject — CUET stays close to it.
- Practise MCQs daily; CUET is objective and speed matters.
- Take full-length mock tests in the NTA computer-based format.
- For the General Test, revise quantitative aptitude, reasoning and current affairs.
- Balance CUET prep with your board exams — both use the same NCERT base.

Common Mistakes

- Choosing domain subjects without checking university requirements.
- Ignoring the language section, which is often scoring.
- No timed mock practice on the CBT interface.
- Starting preparation too late in Class 12.
