History

- The Treaty of Versailles (1919) ended World War I and imposed harsh terms on Germany.
- The Non-Cooperation Movement was launched by Gandhiji in 1920.
- The Civil Disobedience Movement began with the Dandi Salt March in 1930.
- The Rowlatt Act (1919) allowed detention without trial and sparked protests.
- Print culture spread new ideas and fuelled nationalism across the world.

Geography

- Black soil (regur) is ideal for growing cotton.
- Multipurpose river projects provide irrigation, hydro-power and flood control.
- Roadways are the most used mode of transport for short distances in India.
- Conservation of resources means using them wisely for future generations.
- Manufacturing is the backbone of economic development.

Political Science (Civics)

- Federalism divides powers between the central and state governments.
- Democracy is a form of government where rulers are elected by the people.
- Power sharing reduces conflict and ensures political stability.
- Political parties are essential for the working of a democracy.
