Frequent Grammar Mistakes

- Wrong: 'He is more taller.' → Right: 'He is taller.'
- Wrong: 'I am agree.' → Right: 'I agree.'
- Wrong: 'Discuss about the topic.' → Right: 'Discuss the topic.'
- Wrong: 'Return back the book.' → Right: 'Return the book.'
- Wrong: 'One of my friend.' → Right: 'One of my friends.'
- Wrong: 'Less people came.' → Right: 'Fewer people came.'

Confusing Word Pairs

- 'Its' (possessive) vs 'it's' (it is).
- 'Your' (possessive) vs 'you're' (you are).
- 'Their', 'there' and 'they're' — possession, place, they are.
- 'Affect' (verb) vs 'effect' (noun).
- 'Advice' (noun) vs 'advise' (verb).
- 'Then' (time) vs 'than' (comparison).

Preposition & Article Errors

- Wrong: 'Married with' → Right: 'Married to'.
- Wrong: 'Good in maths' → Right: 'Good at maths'.
- Wrong: 'Discuss on' → Right: 'Discuss' (no preposition).
- Use 'a' before consonant sounds, 'an' before vowel sounds.
- Use 'the' for specific nouns, not for general plurals.

Quick Fixes

- Keep tense consistent within a sentence.
- Match subject and verb (he goes, they go).
- Avoid double negatives (not 'don't have no').
- Proofread every piece of writing before submitting.
