- Sociology is the systematic study of society and social relationships.

- Structural change came through colonialism, industrialisation and urbanisation.
- Sanskritisation and Westernisation are processes of cultural change.
- Globalisation affects work, culture and communication in India.

- Social movements: environmental, women's, Dalit and farmers' movements.
- The role of mass media in shaping public opinion.
- Industrialisation changed patterns of work and employment.
- Cultural diversity and national unity coexist in Indian society.

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
