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What Is Changing

- From 2026, CBSE Class 10 board exams are held twice a year.
- First exam: around mid-February – mandatory for all students.
- Second exam: around May – optional, for score improvement.
- You keep the better of the two scores for each subject.

How to Use It Wisely

- Prepare fully for the February exam – do not rely on the second attempt.
- Use the May window for up to three subjects that truly need improvement.
- Internal assessments happen only once, before the first exam.
- A second attempt can only help your score, never lower it.

Planning Your Year

- Finish the syllabus well before February.
- Keep dedicated revision and mock-test time before each exam.
- Aligned with NEP 2020 to reduce one-shot exam pressure.
- Special provisions exist for sports, winter-bound schools & special needs.
